Oh how I love my Fallen. Angel's Kiss is book 4 in the Fallen Warrior's series, bringing readers that much closer to the inevitable war for the safety of mankind. Apparently, the Fallen aren't the only ones who have been laying low, watching and waiting.

Ruby Miller is the leader of a group of rebels who are looking to out the 'white wings' for their true intentions of the human race. Being a nephilim herself, she too has a helpful 'gift' to assist in their mission. She holds a sad, tragic past, one that the Fallen know all too well, so the two groups joining forces makes perfect sense. That being said, not all of the Fallen are mated so with a new female nephilim added to the mix...yeah. that. lol

Michael, who is now mated, finds great amusement in leaving to of his trusted, yet UNmated brethren, Jason and Nate to train the rebels in how to defend against their kind. Both Jason and Nate take notice immediately but it's Jason who is truly enraptured by this beauty, and she him even if she doesn't want to. Ruby's previous loss didn't necessarily make her give up on love but more like fear it and the toll it can take if it's lost along the way. Jason on the other hand knows her for what she is, his mate, but does she?

What I Liked:

I really enjoyed Ruby in this book. She is a strong woman, a leader and a fighter all in one. She has a lot of common sense, until it comes to Jason...but I've learn to discover with these situations that is just impossible to avoid. I loved how she wore sensible, comfortable, almost manly clothes. I mean, they weren't mens attire but they were flannel shirts and cargo pants and lace up boots...tough, reasonable clothes. I also liked the fact that she was a virgin at 26, you don't see that very often nowadays!

I also enjoyed Jason's character. He was definitely more sensitive and understanding. He wasn't as forceful as some of the guys can be when it comes to wanting to claim his mate. What I Didn't Like:

I am going to digress a little bit before giving you my overall opinion of the book...It took me a while to decide what to rate this book. I enjoyed the story, I loved the characters and the action was a lot of fun...however there were a few typo, writing and English errors that it really threw off my concentration at times. I can deal with a typo here and there and sometimes English flies out the window for all of us...but there were a few writing errors that I just couldn't ignore.

The errors really threw the story off...like mentioning one couple and then accidentally replacing them with another couple for one sentence to go back to the correct couple. It had me doing a double take and rereading things to figure out if I had accidentally missed something or confused something. Then there was the part where something was given away, that I didn't remember happening, and then a few paragraphs later we figure out that we weren't supposed to know that happened at all. Those few paragraphs later were supposed to be revealing what happened as a shock factor. If it sounds confusing the way I am explaining it...trust me, it was a bit confusing in this installment of the Fallen Warriors series. :-)

I'd suggest anyone out there who enjoys a fun novella with a strong woman, a slightly more sensitive (but still strong and dominate) man to pick up this novella as well as the previous novellas in the series for a fun, light, quick read.
