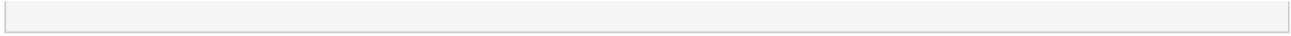

“Born Into Destiny.” Was a glimpse into Dani and Blaze’s struggle about being parents. While I was happy to get a glimpse into Dani’s pregnancy, this wasn’t my favorite book. I feel like we got more of the hormonal fights between Dani and Blaze than her struggles with becoming a mom. The one real fear I got was when she realized she wasn’t paying attention to her son as she should be.

I felt like the book worked more on external dramas rather than the struggle Dani was facing at becoming a mother. Having lost her mother and not feeling sure she could be an actual mother to her children. But, I was glad to see her and Blaze patch their relationship up and to see how much closer the children brought them. We even get to see the twins celebrate their 1st birthday.

My only other thought would be the excessive use of the word “fuck”. For a novella it was used a lot and I felt like it made the storyline stutter. It was very distracting for me, but that could just be a pet peeve of mine.

Although the Forsaken Sinner's MC series CAN be read as standalones, they really shouldn't be. The character development and the history of their relationships build for all of the key players in each and every book. So please do yourself a favor and read *Rewriting Destiny* and *Fighting Destiny* BEFORE you read this one.

The series started with the rocky path Dani and Zane had to travel on their way to find one another again. Since then they've been together and in love. They fight a lot, but that's just them. They're passionate about each other and that's bound to mean huge blow ups, but that passion also carries into their good times together and their sexual relationship. (Which makes for some really hot scenes to read!) Zane worships everything about Dani and that comes through with every kiss and touch. He's also the epitome of the alpha MC guy; his over-protectiveness and loyalty to the club are the main reasons they fight. But they're also the reasons she loves him as deeply as she does.

Zane is even more unduly protective of Dani after finding out she's pregnant. We see as to what extent in *Fighting Destiny*. Because of that I was a little bit shocked and annoyed with him for finding out how much time he was spending away from Dani due to what he said was 'club business'. Even after reading the whole story and finding out why he had to be away dealing with some things, I was still upset. I felt like being with Dani while she was progressing in the pregnancy should've come first. Luckily for Zane, she loves the club as much as he does and accepts that way of life and loves him for it.

Pregnancy is not making their relationship any easier. Dani's mood swings cause even more fights, Zane's absences hurt her and have her questioning what he's hiding from her and how he's feeling about the baby and their relationship. There's a growing distance between them that tore at my heart. I was yelling at my phone that they just needed to talk to one another!! But they're both stubborn and when they do talk they don't say with all honesty exactly what's going on. As the weeks pass, they drift further and further apart. I hated watching this, I'd rather they be screaming at one another than to not interact at all.

Sometimes it takes monumentally prodigious life event for people to get their heads out of their a\$\$es and realize what really matters in their lives. That's what happens with Zane and Dani. In book 2.5 of the series, we're back to focusing on Dani and Blaze. We're watching as her pregnancy progresses and how things are going for the two of them. It is rather funny to read Blaze's irrational behavior about her being pregnant. Always making sure she's monitored and that someone is there to take her wherever she needs to go or to do whatever it is she needs to do. She's not disabled. She's just pregnant, a fact she keeps reminding him off but he never gets the clue. It is too funny. As we watch Dani progress in her pregnancy, there are some strange things going on with Blaze. What is happening? Why is he telling her he is taking care of club business and then when she calls the club and talks to Mack, he doesn't know what she's talking about? Is he cheating? Book One gives us Danielle and Zanes story. We meet the two main characters while they are in their early years. Needing a better place to stay other than the motel she is currently seeking shelter in; she takes the room available at the tattoo shop. Coming into her own years later she hears the voice of a man who left her wounded and on her own How can this be the same person she lost so long ago and why does he have no idea who she is.

Fighting Destiny

This is the second release in the Forsaken Sinners MC series. Both of these characters suffered from emotional and physical abuse. Beware if you have triggers. Toby and Sara. Sara is running from her past of abuse from boyfriend. A man who took things from her she cannot replace. Refusing to be a victim any longer she hopes she can run far enough away from the monster that threatens to control her. Sara needs to learn how to defend herself just in case he comes to find her or her current job puts her in the line of fire. Sara refuses to ever be a victim again. Being in control is something she needs for herself to make it through healing from her past. Toby helps his trainer out at the gym, does some underground fighting and is a member of the FS. Dani and Blaze are happy and Toby wonders if he can have the same thing they do. Both fought to survive and came back from the dark so maybe he can too. The secondary story in this release deals with some members not agreeing due to an incident which I believe leaves a prologue and a sneak peek into our next release.

Born Into Destiny

This is a continuation; a short novella of Danielle and Zane; expecting parents. Dani isn't sure of how she is going to handle motherhood but Zane knows she will be fantastic. In usual form Zane is behaving like an obsessed man after finding out his girlfriend is pregnant. He isn't allowing her to do anything or much less even act like a functioning person. When in old friend comes back into Dani's life things start to get a little interesting. Zane seems to not be where he says he is going to be and secrets start to unfold. The toll on the relationship hasn't even begun yet .. you thought it did in their release but nothing like what we see here. Not to give anything away you are going to be frustrated and think Dani and Zane are never going to get it right Keep turning the pages and don't hold your breath because it's a wild one.
