At this point, Ms. Edwards' books have become rather formulaic. All too often the beautiful white girl is kidnapped by a handsome Indian chief (or the son of a chief) Never is the man just a regular warrior, I've read about ten of these books (handed down to me) and it seems that in Ms. Edwards' books, only the chief (or prince) is worthy of having a beautiful white woman for himself. Dialogue is as clunky in here as it is in her other books, with some utterly unrealistic lines, especially from the main character/heroine, she swings between fierce devotion to her chief yet at other times she hates him and thinks he's a no-good liar despite his heartfelt efforts to prove otherwise.
