I knew after reading the first book that these two authors were perfect together and know how to write an amazing book. Filthy Bastard is a standalone MC novel. I believe that you don't have to read the first book to understand this book, but it is my STRONG recommendation that you read these books in order. We have some story overlap in this book, that I think would make more sense after reading Dirty Bastard (Book 1). Plus you meet both Addy and Brew in book 1 and their story is started in that book also. In this book we dive more into who Addy and Brew really are. I personally don't like reading about rape in my books, but I will be honest and say that the way this is written, it wasn't uncomfortable for me to read. It did make my heart break on many occasions, but I was never squeamish while reading this book.
