The story isn't particularly bad. It was rather simple but interesting, however, I still had some issues with it. All the characters with the exception of Michelle and Kumar were utterly annoying, sometimes you could see there was something that tried to be a change of perspective but that, ultimately, lead to a confusion because I lost track of whose emotions were those supposed to be. While writing in third person gives you the freedom to explore more in depth all of the character's emotions, this book failed at this multiple perspective.
