We get to know about Jaymeson in the 3rd book of the Seaside Series (Shatter), he is fun to be around, his friendship with Alec and Demetri is solid BUT he likes to sleep around. Basically that's Fall in a few words and I have to say that I LOVE the book. Really, it has everything I'm looking in a book. I went from laughing to be mad and then crying and then just sighing.
