Larry A Winters brings suspense and twists in this book that kept me interested and turning the page. He

adds characters to the story that help to develop the plot. Jessie's love interest Leary takes a bigger role in this story, but I'd be surprised if he stays very long in books #4 or #5. Jessie shows she is a successful, talented, smart woman who doesn't need the distraction or drama of a man. I liked the female character Graham who shows us the dynamics of Jessie working with other women, and trying to make a friend. In Deadly Evidence, Larry A. Winters has a good, easy to read writing style that is getting better in every book. He holds my attention, and gives enough detail that I can picture everything that is happening. There is plenty of action and characters in the story to keep the plot going at a steady pace. He doesn't include a lot of fluff or nonsense just to add more pages – this I appreciate.
