The ending, awkwardly as it appeared, implies a book 2, as does the title, I couldn't find it. I actually would like to see what happens. The author packed a lot into the story by staying on the surface of activity and potential drama. But, she did manage to give us pretty developed characters. However, her story only took up 60% of the book.

The second story was a short bwwm pregnancy romance titled Carrying his baby by Vanessa Brown. In this story, a one night stand creates an unplanned pregnancy. The parents came to a compromise that worked for both until it didn't. They spent together and eventually wanted to be a true family and share their lives as one. Again, the characters were fairly developed and the author stayed on the service with activity and had no drama in the story to create an interesting storyline. She takes us through the beginning of the 3rd-trimester check-up visit and we are dropped abruptly from the lives of these two characters. I could not get invested enough to want to see the outcome of this story. There was not enough to pull me into this one. I think it has potential. Potential I hope is met in book 2.
