Hmm... So, in some ways, this book was better than the first one, in some ways, it's no better, and in some ways, it's worse.

It's better because it seems to be a bit more believable, and also in terms of the editing. I complained in my last review about really shoddy editing: missing words, typos, stuff like that. Well, I still spotted some of those in this book, but not nearly as many. Much better!

Similar to the first one, it's written mostly in first-person-present-tense. But I didn't understand the tense switching. Typically, when a story's written in this style, there's a specific and deliberate decision on the author's part to put some scenes into past tense, and it normally means there's a flashback happening, or we're otherwise hearing about something that happened prior to the events being described by the present tense. But there seemed to be no rhyme or reason to the tense switches.

Finally, I felt that at a certain point, there are just so many different groups after our protagonist (this was around 75% in, I think), that it's difficult to keep track. I skimmed a lot when I got to that part.

Otherwise, another decent story, and a fitting conclusion to the previous instalment. There's a third volume in this series, but it doesn't seem to have anything to do with the first two, so I'll give it a miss.
