I felt a lot of things when I was listening to Reviving Izabel. I knew what was going to happen, but listening to books just makes you feel everything for the first time again. Whew, what a thrilling, all-consuming, fascinating and utterly entertaining ride this was! I already loved the previous book in this series and it doesn't happen often that the sequel rivals or even outshines the prequel but in this case that's exactly what happened. Told from a dual POV, this sequel is even more riveting, exciting and unputdownable and it made me an even bigger fan of author J.A. Redmerski.

Reviving Izabel picks up eight months after everything that transpired at the end of book one. Sarai is trying to build up a normal, violent-less life but when she's once again confronted with Arthur Hamburg she decides to take matters into her own hands and she hunts him down. When circumstances bring Victor back into her life though, she realizes how much she still needs his help and when he decides to help her, their feelings start to reignite.

There is never a dull moment in the lives of Sarai Cohen/Izabel Seyfried and Victor Faust, that's for sure. The entire book kept me on the edge of my seat and the way the book evolved was never predictable or uneventful.

Sarai is a unique, very likable heroine with an incredibly strong, tough as nails personality. Throughout the story she evolves from an innocent, naive victim to a fervent, determined killer. She still has a lot to learn but
