I felt like this was heavily influenced by White Oleander without having the haunting, lyrical prose that turned that book, also a story of survival in the foster care system after being abandoned by an insane mother, into a masterpiece. I generally liked Sinden West's prose but I grew to hate the ultimately melodramatic, nonsensical plot. This book is dark. It made me hate men via the p.o.v. of the heroine and yet, I did not feel the empathy I should with her either. Violet is too passive and self-hating to make her a compelling character that I can root for. This book was unfortunately a fail for me.
