Graphic illustrations of 75 US National Parks, Monuments, etc, by various illustrators through the Creative Action Network. Nice browsing book. My problem is the text to each of the sites covered is only a few sentences, and uses up less than half of the descriptive page. Could have given us more. Also, the illustrators bios are alpha by first name - ????? And 2 of them, done by what appears to be artist cooperatives, are not included in the bios.

Some of the illustrations are great, some are "meh", all in a similar style. I find it strange that in a few cases the illustrators have not even visited the site! Nah, not a good idea.

But overall, enjoyable, and introduced me to some sites I was not aware of before. Also a good reminder that many of these sites have become national, and protected, only in the last 50 years or so - as our current WH admin tries to attack the natural, often pristine, environment of the sites. I believe CAN sells poster and postcards of these, and other, graphics on their website. Wish the book, and so the illustrations, were bigger. But a good evening browser.
