I'm not usually a fan of insta-attraction/love stories, but this one was very well done. The hero's situation absolutely broke my heart and I was dying for him to achieve a HEA - with or without the stubborn heroine at some points!

While I understood where the heroine was coming from, and have had some of the same parental experiences, I often felt she was unfair to the hero. She comes to her senses at the end, so all is forgiven, but I didn't like her as much as the hero.

There is a low heat level in this story, but there is an acknowledged intensity between the main characters that I absolutely adored. Too often, when characters aren't sleeping together, an author has a hard time showing how much the characters *want* to sleep together, but Katie Meyer has no such trouble. I loved that they even had an open communication on the subject.

I haven't read the two previous stories in the series, but I never felt lost. I recommend this for anyone who loves a sweet romance between two souls that were looking for each other.
