Ok. Like many others: main character has a surprise destiny to save the world. The only thing is that though she seems to be able to give extra power to her mate it doesn't seem overly impressive and what the danger to the world is isn't even mentioned. There are some other problems as well. The parents don't seem to put up much fight about moving to another country in a few hours abandoning their daughter, their home, work, etc. Why does she have to be so quiet in the beginning and why so domineering with her? That doesn't necessarily seem a characteristic of their leader at other times so why now when you would be trying to get her compliance.

However, I do like how the relationship develops between Natasha and the dragon. He makes an attempt at giving her what she wants for her own sanity. Natasha isn't completely unreasonable about her safety when she discovers beings are trying to kill her. Sometimes the heroine is unreasonable about wanting her freedom in spite of the knowledge that multiple beings want them dead. Heroines and heroes can act very stupidly as if they don't even have common sense. A sense of romance between the two does develop even if it starts out very abruptly without any communication.

If this is the complete series as the title hints it does not end with any real sense of completion because the world hasn't been saved. In fact, the world hasn't been in any real danger.
