This was such a delightful story, turned on its head in so many ways.

Our Beast, Herb, has been cursed with his appearance but has no castle to haunt. Apparently the curse wants a castle so....Herb finds a castle. It just so happens that Herb needs an enchanted castle, which requires an enchanter. The only enchanter no to run away is the surly Beldon, who enjoys Herb's company. But the two soon set out to find out what happened with the curse and where it when wrong, going on a quest to figure out how to make things right again.

Herb is quite possibly the sweetest person ever! He has spent a large portion of his life mostly ignored- not unloved just unnoticed- but that hasn't made him bitter or angry. Instead, Herb is kind, caring, and very empathetic. He is most notably concerned about anyone being lonely and goes to lengths to make sure that all those around him are happy. However, if you happen to cross someone that Herb is loyal to you'll meet a truly fierce beast! Herb was so wonderful and lovable.

Beldon is angry and short tempered, largely for the same issue as Herb flipped on its head; he cannot escape notice, but is thought to be a very beautiful *woman* . It angers Beldon to no end to always be mistaken for a woman, so he stays away from people instead. Beldon isn't cruel though and is kind to those he cares about and those who have won his respect. This drives him to find an end to Herb's curse and brings the two together.

A wonderful story that is then interconnected with plenty of short stories of their antics before and after meeting, as well as the sweetly sad story of Herb's parents. A delightful read!

I thought it was sweet, and I loved reading about them together. However, the short length made some of the time passed a little too fast, and things happened off page. Especially because Aiden and Sabin pretty much connected throughout the journey to find Morgemeil, so I would love to read those moments instead of being glossed over.
