Quick and to the Point

Volume 25

Kagome has been captured by the poison master of the band of seven (only there aren't seven of them anymore). Sango and Monk manage to get to her before he can do anything unsavory to her. But the poison master has a few tricks up his sleeve! With no InuYasha to save them, who will rescue their bacon?

Kagome and the others escape certain death by poison only to be thrown into danger again. This situation will almost certainly guarantee their deaths! InuYasha better get his sh*t in order!!!

Weakened and unwell, Sango, Monk and Kagome are relying on InuYasha to keep them safe. But the band of seven aren't finished with them yet. Fortunately Koga shows up to vervally rip a strip off of InuYaasha when trouble arrives....but sometimes trouble arrives in threes and the weak must rise to the occasion or perish.

Volume 26

Things just keep getting worse as the gang (and Koga) face down the remaining five of the band of seven. Meanwhile, Sesshomaru and his gang attempt to climb Mount Hakurei only to find it shielded. Only Rin can pass through to discover what is beyond. InuYasha and friends continue battle the remaining five. InuYasha leads his merry band to a village that is missing their holy man. They agree to help (because the island he disappeared on holds the key to the energy shield (that is purifying the mountain). Bankotsu (the band of seven leader) greets them there and once again he and InuYasha battle. Only this time, Bankotsu has a sacred jewel shard in his sword!

Volume 27

Koga continues to face down 2 of the 5 Of the band of 7 (Starting to sound like a Borg designation). Sesshomaru takes on the snake sword pretty boy while Jaken tries to save himself and Rin from the multiple personality doctor (the evil side, currently). Of course, Sesshomaru ends up with two opponents and a hostage situation...

Koga gets a rescue from InuYasha (and Kagome) only to land in a fiery situation. InuYasha, Kagome, and Koga handle the fire and explosion expert of the band of seven rather nicely, though he gets away.

Sango and Monk continue to hurry ahead, trying to find the living Buddha, Naraku and whatever else might be hiding in the mountain.
