As you might expect, it's fairly lurid and bizzarre, whilst not being quite detailed enough for my purposes! There's some interesting ideas in here, but the writing offers it all from a very theoretical perspective, it's a bit dry. It falls between two stools, not really being academic, not really pornographic. It's just not detailed enough to give serous perverts a kick, or smut writers enough raw material.
