I went into this book without reading any reviews. (There were none.)

The H, Jax, used to be in a MC but some things went down and now he lives outside the town.
The h, Christina, is running from an abusive ex. She feisty but has a softness about her.

They meet when Christina is going to visit her parents for a few days but ends up in a very bad snow storm with no cell service, little gas & no blanket to keep her warm. In comes the hero who sees her from his window and digs her out. He takes her to his house for the duration of the storm.
Things start out a little rocky but eventually both are so attracted to each other the fall into bed.
Christina is of course in la la Love land so she is already planning a future after one night while Jax is holding himself back because of his past. Her crazy Ex-boyfriend Tommy starts to harass her any way he can which gets Jax in protective mode.

The snow storm ends and Christina leaves Jax's house with them having exchanged numbers.
Of course her friend she works with tells her all the town gossip about Jax and how he's bad and whatnot.
This makes Christina disgusted with having fell for Jax in that short amount of time and believing she has bad instincts towards men. She avoids his texts and phone calls until something happens involving her ex.
Jax comes to the rescue to help her.

An ex MC member comes in to shake things up and sends Jax running leaving Christina vulnerable against her psychotic ex. When Jax cools off a bit and goes to talk with Christina he finds her missing. Needing help he goes to the MC guy who caused some shit earlier for help in exchange for the truth on what really happened in the past.

Jax finds her, gets hurt in the process of trying to save her. They exchange I Love You's and move in together after knowing each other for about 2 weeks max.

Now, I think the book moved kind of quick. I'm no stranger to a insta-love book or a quick little novella but when its a full novel and things progress quickly like this I cant quite connect with either character. There isn't really that much time spent between the main characters. You don't get the sense that they KNOW each other. You have one secondary character Amy who really doesn't even bring anything to the table. She just seems to be helpful at work and a little gossipy.

Jax was pretty boring. He's no longer in the MC so we don't even get a glimpse into that world. Hes a landscaper but we don't get anything with that either. He remains a big mystery for the most part. All we really know about him is a fast little rundown on how he grew up and what went down with his ex-wife. We're supposed to think he's this monster based on the blurb but he wasn't, not at all. Christina was boring too. She didn't bring anything to the table other than ex drama. I feel like I know even less about her than Jax, if that's possible.

Romance novels always have to throw in a kidnapping, shooting, car accident or huge misunderstanding when the book is going well. I don't see the point. Save all the writing you're going to do on those scenes and put it towards connecting the characters. Give me something to love about them. Something that makes me wish this was a series. I'm a no muss, no fuss, light drama and angst reader. This was pretty light of the drama though I felt it wasn't needed anyway.

It wasn't the worst book I've read that's for sure but I wouldn't pick it up again. I wouldn't outright
