To start with, the story should have begun about 30 minutes earlier where a significant event takes place that first makes Craig notice Shelby.

I like reading erotica written by women as they in general care more about making realistic characters, rather than churning out porn. However the drawback of that is that you get what you get here, where Craig immediately decides that "she's the one" and this before he has even really met her, talked with her.. gotten to know her name, for Christ's sake!

I could have bought that he "had to have her", "had to get to know her" or "felt a lump at the pit of his stomach at the thought of her with anyone else" and then build on that, but "we are fated to be together forever" without even knowing that they have similar tastes and plans in life just doesn't work for me. Shelby is presented as a spitfire and more than once, but there is nothing in her actions or the dialogue to validate that label.
