**What I Liked and Didn't:**

While I dislike reading short stories, I must say that this is probably my favourite of the series. It still has the issues of a short story, such as a lack of depth of character and a shortened plot that has plot aspects skimmed over for the right length. The rest of the series I wondered whether making it a full length would make it better or worse but I think that this book would be better if it was longer. The plot was skimmed over and the lie about Jaden suddenly makes everything alright was a stupid idea. Character-wise, Michaela was an alright character but I feel like the fact she's zoo keeper could have been made bigger and more humourous. Kye was also alright and I don't know but the idea of a massive guy changing a tiny baby's nappy is quite a funny thought.

**Final Thoughts:**

While this may be the best of the series so far, I still can't put it any higher than two stars because I just don't think it's worth a three star rating. Sure, it was an easier and somewhat enjoyable read but it was still a meh short story so I can't be too positive. If I'd read it on it's own, it wouldn't be a good read but compared to the rest of the series it's good.

Would I recommend it? Nope but the zoo aspect made me want to re-read another shifter romance so I wouldn't recommend this one.

Will I be carrying on? Two more books so why not, plus I'd read them originally four years ago and don't want to leave them at a decent rating when I'm not really liking the series.
