Collin goes into specific detail regarding the different blind levels, and also when it gets late, when & how to push/fold. I've read the Harrington on Hold 'Em series (1/2), and 2+2 generally puts out good material. I've read this close to 3 times over now, digging more and more into the concepts each time, highlighting the details of each hand explanation and outcome to make it easier to review. The section on High-Blind play is particularly excellent. Understanding high-blind play is critical to tournament poker as the gameplay is vastly different than that of a cash game.
