Casey Cramer is a cool, sophisticated home and garden talk show host on K-YAK 102.5 radio station. All she thinks she wants is to talk about fertilizer and place settings, while fending off her well-meaning country club parents' attempts to push her into marriage with the "right man."

To Casey, fellow talk show host, Rip O'Rourke, is nothing more than a rebellious, overgrown teenager flaunting his Hawaiian-shirted, ex-football player physique to "score" with anything with breasts. Proof of his perversity is the crude, but popular, hour of programming he hosts that discusses such manly topics as wet T-shirt contests and sports statistics. Casey wouldn't spit on Rip if he were on fire, while Rip, on the other hand, wants to do more than spend time with Casey. She is a challenge to mankind as a whole and his goal in life is to see her crisp shirts and tailored slacks properly rumped, just once.

Rip gets his opportunity when the radio station is sold to a large corporation and the station manager is challenged to come up with a prime-time show that will set the city on its ear. From one of Rip and Casey's public arguments springs the idea for a show about the differences between men and women, and giving their audience, "Something to Talk About."

This was a cute romance and I enjoyed it, but it contained a couple of subplots that turned out to be irrelevant bunny trails (one of my pet peeves.) The male protagonist (Tom) is a self-made billionaire who belongs to a club consisting of other men who are also self-made billionaires. In the beginning of the book, the 'club' meets regularly and members support one another in all aspects of life. Tom keeps his wealth a secret from his father (why?) and continues to work at the family's used-car lot because he made a deathbed promise to his mom. He isn't good at selling cars and doesn't like doing it, but he finds he does enjoy making live

commercials with a skimpily-clad actress and various wild animals. The commercials always go badly, but in a hilarious manner and with positive outcomes. The relationship that develops between the billionaire and the actress is funny and sweet. The relationship between his father and his buddy is also fun. The writing is good and entertaining. So what's the problem?

The bunny trails were distracting and unsatisfying. The 'billionaire's club' disappears without a trace very early in the book, leaving the reader to wonder why we were introduced to characters who have no impact on the storyline whatsoever. Tom never uses his money to help accomplish a goal, get himself out of a scrap or anything else... not even in the epilog, so why make him a billionaire at all? Tom is supposed to be terrible at his job, yet he closes the only big deal he is assigned (to acquire a fleet of used cars from a make-up mogul/cougar who has her eyes set on Tom.)The cougar also disappears without a trace. And the deathbed promise he and his father both made to his mother? Well, that disappears, too... without a mention. If the bunny trails were removed from the book or better incorporated into the plot, this book would have rated more stars.
