I KNOW I said I wouldn't be active for the next few days (that's still the case), but I simply *couldn't* leave Wicked Sexy unfinished. This book is the second installment of the Wicked Games Series, I much preferred this story to its predecessor, which is an INCREDIBLY rare feat.

I loved so many things about this book. For one, Tabitha West, who was introduced in Wicked Beautiful as Victoria Price's hacker-genius-assistant, is the leading lady, and she's a total snarky, super-intelligent bad bitch. Then, there's Connor Hughes, who's the half-Samoan, half-Irish owner and operator of a security firm called Metrix. Both Tabitha and Connor were racially ambiguous in Wicked Sexy (the description of Connor as being half-Samoan was only mentioned in Wicked Beautiful). But that did not stop me from visualizing Connor as a FABM.

Another thing I loved about this story was that it was *intelligent*, without being over-my-head intelligent. Do you know what I mean? SOMETIMES I'm in the mood for a super-heavy psychological thriller, and SOMETIMES (*cough cough* more often than not) I'm in the mood for something vapid and senseless that doesn't require much brain use. THIS book falls in the middle on the depth-spectrum.

I love how J.T. Geissinger incorporates feminism into ~~her stories~~ (who am I kidding these are the only two books I've read by her - I'll get into more of her stuff ASAP) THIS SERIES. I love a story with a good, strong, heroine (it helps if she's funny too). From Tabby's introduction in the previous book, I did not expect to love her story this much, but I think the fact that this story takes place 3 years after the culmination of the previous book, gives us the chance to see a more "developed" version of Tabby.

Despite being focused on hyper-intelligent characters, I liked that these mega-smart people often made some really fucking stupid mistakes. I didn't perceive these mistakes as plot holes, I perceived them as character flaws that helped make the characters relatable.

It's 10pm and I have to be awake at 5am to being an 1800km drive so forgive me for this poor review; I'm not sure how to tactfully weave this quote into this review, but it's my favourite quote from this book and I feel like I have to share it:

“Should I jump to the ending? Spoiler alert: the hero saves her.”

Tabby looks over at me, her eyes shining like gems in the dark. “A real hero would teach the princess how to save herself.”

REAL heroes don't save princesses, they teach the princesses how to save themselves. Princesses don't need heroes to teach them things, they can teach themselves, and that's probably more inspirational. However, in the context of the story, I interpreted the focus as less on heroes and princesses and more on the fact that: Through healthy, positive relationships we become the *best* version of ourselves. And that resonated.

I will most definitely be reading this again (who knows, maybe I'll read it again and hate it, but in this

moment, I loved it - bloody hell, am I the champion of backhanded reviews or what? I'm going to shut up now before I confuse you even more).

Connor loves to bait Tabitha, but Tabitha is always on top of her game and gives Connor her spit-fire tongue-lashing at every turn. I loved every single word between these two. Their relationship drips with sarcasm and perfection.

"God, why do you hate me? Seriously, what have I done to offend you so deeply that you'd burden me with this ridiculous—"

"Ahem. Heroic," Connor interrupts.

"Brilliant."

convincing times), Tabby agrees, but the story takes an unexpected turn that I did not see coming at all. Tabby has a past that is dark and scary, and Connor is the type of hero who will murder for her.

“Love your tears, princess, ‘cause I know you’d never give them to anyone but me,” he murmurs into my ear.

J.T. writes some badass motherfuckers, and I’m not talking about the guys (although they are pretty badass too). The HEROINE in this book!!!! TABBY! Total girl-crush going on over here. I want to BE her, from her hello kitty watch to her dirty, badass mouth....everything. She has had a shit-load of life handed to her, but she is strong as steel. She has learned to hack her way into protecting herself and her heart. Tabitha is a genius hacker. She is just so....cool! I want to be Tabby when I grow up.

“Is that a Hello Kitty watch she’s wearing?” I turn and glare at him, my hands curled to fists, “Yeah, motherfucker, it is. And in two seconds it’s going to be telling the time inside your colon.”

Book 1 of Wicked Games series, **Wicked Beautiful** is one of my favorite books, it was worth more than 5 stars for me. If I could, I would give it 10 stars!

We meet the main characters of Book 2, Tabby and Connor in Book 1. Although Book 2 can be read as a stand-alone, please read Book 1 first because it is where you will fall in love with Tabby and her quick wit. It is where you will see the first sparks between Tabby and Connor. Don't miss that experience. Book 2, **Wicked Sexy** is good on its own but starting Book 2 being already in love with the main characters adds so much to the joy of reading Tabby and Connor's story.

Connor is an ex-Special Ops officer and the CEO of his private security firm, Metrix Security. Tabby is a genius computer hacker who attended MIT when she was very young and she was one of the two best students there. Her IQ level is surprisingly high and she has a photographic memory. She outwits everyone in the field, and can hack almost every private or government systems. Her nickname, Polaroid is very well-known in the cyber world. She leaves a hello kitty cat as her signature.

Tabby is a very intriguing character. Although Connor calls her "princess", she is not one of these kind, shy and romantic princesses in fairy tales. She is unique. She has quick wit but also a quick temper. She is beautiful with red hair, she is sexy, smart and funny but she is also stubborn, crazy and wild. She is feisty and sassy. Her mouth has no filter. She gives as good as she gets.

But she has walls around herself that she has built up to protect herself from being hurt. She doesn't trust anyone but herself. She is wounded and suffers from some old demons.

Connor is a well-built man who is older than Tabby and he is beautiful both inside and outside. He is an alpha hero who is very protective. Connor is loyal to the ones he cares about. He is dominant but he has a soft spot for Tabby. He can sometimes act like a jackass but he is very sweet and charming.

Being a very observant and intelligent man himself, Connor sees through Tabby's walls and he understands her, he wants to be there for her. He adores her intelligence but he is also extremely attracted to her. Tabby is also attracted to Connor but she tries to hate him not to fall for him.

Tabby and Connor met in Book 1 while they were helping their friends, Tabby helping Victoria, Connor helping Parker. Their first encounter was electric. Sparks were flying in the air. Just at that moment, I craved for Book 2, wondering how they will turn to lovers from enemies. Yes, their story is their journey from being enemies to friends and then finally lovers.

In their story, there is almost everything from crime to passion, from suspense to steamy hot sex, from humor to a slow-built love story. The suspense element in the story is blended with the romantic plot in a seamless way. The witty and hilarious banter between Tabby and Connor made me laugh out loud. Tabby looks at me. She says softly, "He'll end it."

Now these are some heart-warming and hot excerpts...

From the first moment I met these characters in *Wicked Beautiful*, I could not get them out of my head, the mere suggestion of all that could happen between them, given their history, setting my mind spinning and my heart aflutter, and I was so impatient to read this book, I think I devoured it in one breath. A spicy, highly amusing game of cat and mouse between a former Marine, now self-employed commando and cyber-security expert, and a quirky, Hello-Kitty-obsessed computer genius who outsmarts him every chance she gets, this was one of the sexiest books I’ve read this year, and one I can recommend unreservedly.
