Basically, this book is encouraging those who read it to do whatever they want to or can put their minds to. It's kind of like "Oh the place you'll go!" by Dr. Seuss in the way that it goes over all these things that you can do-such as following your dreams (but holding on tight) or seeing sights that take your breath away.
