I enjoyed this second chance love story between Leah and Alistair...though the beginning of the book where Leah is second guessing her decision to not tell Alistair he has a child is a bit too long and slow. The reader has a good sense of the internal struggle Leah has as a single parent trying to provide everything for her daughter, yet coming up short. I found Leah likeable, especially when her only two close friends, Emma and Mathilda, call her out when she starts overthinking things, and she accepts responsibility for some of her actions/thoughts.

Because this story was told from a dual point of view, we could also hear inside Alistair's head as he struggled to reign in the control tendency behavior that ultimately drove Leah away 5 years ago. We're able to "hear" the surprise in Leah's head when she expects him to be the old "we're going to do it this way" Alistair, and instead, he's open to listening to her view, and deferring to her as the "expert" in the parenting department.

As a couple they do face a threat, but with faith and team work, they're able to reach their HEA.
