There are rumors that she fell for some travelling man years ago and that is why she doesn't date, but the reality is very different. Our hero is scarred, physically scarred from what we can see and emotionally too. When the heroine starts receiving threats the hero is at hand to protect her and they gradually start suspecting it ties back to the attack on the heroine.
