Whereas Sophie is easily embarrassed, quiet, sweet and sentimental, with her brown, shoulder-length hair she is quite, well... average. But when Kylie signs *them both* up for cheerleading tryouts, Sophie's world is turned upside down in a back handspring sort of way.
