I have always been one of your biggest fans. Even the stuff I've hated, I've still read. So when you said you had decided to forgo traditional publishing and go indie, I thought, well, okay, maybe the publishers are not letting you write more books about your imaginary Victorian world with the overtones of alien-ness and steampunk. And I love that world. So more of that = happy me.

However.

If this is what you had planned to do with your indie career, I am begging you, BEGGING YOU, to go back to traditional publishing. This felt--unfinished. Amateur. Not worthy of you. I'm sure you've read Bettye Sharp's novella "Ember", which is a very sexy, very dark retelling of Cinderella. Maybe you read it and thought, hey, I'd like to write a fairy tale. Well, you're certainly entitled to do so, but this is just...not very good.

After I'd read this, I went back and dug out the anthology Hot Spell, with your wonderful short story The Countess's Pleasure, and re-read that. There is simply no comparison: these two stories don't seem like they were written by the same person! The Countess's Pleasure is well edited, written superbly, and I love both the characters. I'm INVESTED in their relationship, which is sexy, erotic, and romantic. This story, while it feels slightly more humorous than your other work (except maybe Fairyville) doesn't engage me. I don't feel interested in the hero or the heroine. They aren't interesting people.
