AUTUMN HEALING is a short menage read where events unfold and romance blossoms at warp speed.

In the hidden valley of Sanctuary lives 4 sets of twins who are also Irish Wolfhound shifters who are each in search of a mate to share. AUTUMN HEALING, the fourth and final book in the Welcome to the Sanctuary series, is where the final set of twins find their mate.

After a series of events leads to her sudden departure from the army, Autumn takes a good look in the mirror and realizes she doesn't like the person staring back at her. Autumn decides to make a change by cutting out all men in her life. In an attempt to give her something else to focus on and help to pull her out of her funk, Autumn's father ships her off to Sanctuary to aid in the birth of her sister's children, the next generation of shape-shifting Irish Wolfhounds.

In Sanctuary, she feels at peace with her life for the first time in a long time. When she steps out of her car, her senses are bombarded with the very enticing pheromones of twin brothers, Frank and Evan. The twins smell good enough to eat and look equally delicious. When she walks into their furniture shop, she feels like she's a hot meal to the starving men. Too bad for them, because she has sworn off men individually, much less 2 of them but their eyes say they don't care what she says because they are ready to devour her.

I am well aware of how quickly things progress in the paranormal world, but they went from "Hi" to "My nipples are aching" in record time. I feel that this story would benefit from a little more character and plot development. It just didn't have enough of a story to really pull me in. It was just okay for me, I wasn't wowed. Autumn Healing sees the final twins mated. The Sanctuary series consists of four books and brings together a family of shifters with four sets of twins and a family of the four seasons. The twins are Irish wolfhound shifters who meet siblings Spring, Summer, and Autumn and their brother Winter. Each finds their significant other in the twin shifters who are destined to find a single mate between the two of them.

The book was well edited, plot line was solid and it flowed well if a little too quickly. The main female protagonist, Autumn, is suffering from a trauma caused during her tour in the Army. It has made her afraid of men. Her shifter mates are the perfect ones to help heal the damage but unfortunately, the story moved a little too quickly. She goes from afraid of men and wary of them right into a committed relationship in less than 24 hrs. While consistent with the rest of the series, with falling instantly in love and feeling the instant

pull of destined mates, the story would have been a better read if the story had gone a little slower.

The twins however, were wonderful in the caring, compassion and empathy they showed their mate. This helped to create an engaging story. Overall, however, it's a good book and a decent read. More, the entire series is recommended.
