The novel has two sets of romance plot lines but the main focus is Gabriel and Annie. Annie is responsible for ensuring the group, Bel Homme, stays in line and gets things done. In short, she's an overpaid babysitter for four grown men. The plus for her is that all four of them respect, bond, and like her so they are much more willing to listen to her than to argue with her.
