Shattered Lies is the final book in The Unraveled Series by Theresa Sederholt. Books 1 and 2, The Unraveling of Raven and Darkness into Dawn, must be read before this one – it is not a standalone novel.

The story Shattered Lies (The Unraveled Trilogy Book 3) by Theresa Sederholt is a suspense romance book. This is the last book in a trilogy that is about the lives of Jax and Raven, along with their best friends and family. We start with everyone in Scotland attempting to start over. While nothing is perfect you start to see a glimmer of hope for everyone. Then like the jaws of a shark unforeseen circumstances tear into everyone's lives. Danger surrounds everyone as an old enemy receives assistance by a new foe in their quest for revenge. What Jax has been trying to achieve, a safe place for his family and friends, is farther out of reach than ever before.
