*Eversong* is outside the realm of the genres that I usually read within, but I'm so happy I picked it up because it's a breathtaking story!

Historical elements were woven into this piece, and I loved the presence of witches, wizards, warlocks, and the like. Grant painted a picture with her words, and I found myself catapulted into this space that had both paranormal and fantasy elements to it.

I enjoyed the plot of this story. First off, this book was literally magically delicious!
