I'm not a huge fan of celebrity stories but this one was fun. For the first time in a long time both characters were celebrities in their own rights. Bella was an actress while Sam was a hotelier. Sam, the smokin' hot, billionaire has always had a bit of a thing for her and finally gets his shot.

The story was sort of "Love Unscripted" lite. Bella was on the run from photographers at a spa and she crashed into Sam. He pulled her into his office and proceeded to make sure she was safe before attempting any sort of romance. Of course his alpha-maleness came out right after the photographer had been dealt with.
