He didn't know what for he'd volunteered until he learned it was to accompany twelve mail-order brides, first on ship to Skagway, Alaska, then on into Canada, the town of white horse, where miners were waiting for brides.

An ambush follows and an early storm causes the ship to pile up on rocks, sinking. Of the seventy people aboard, only twenty survived. Two of the brides drowned and most of the crew and passengers.
