Beautifully illustrated and creatively put together, *Turned Upside Down* is dedicated to children who have lost a loved one, and it is meant to be read as a conversation between a child and an adult. Many parents and/or guardians struggle with understanding how to comfort a grieving child, and Teana Tache makes it easy to open conversations that allow a child to process what has happened. The first half of the book is written from a child's perspective and the second half is written from the perspective of the person who has passed away. The first part describes thoughts that every person has when they lose someone, such as the things they miss about the person and how lost they currently feel. The last half of the book includes what their loved one would be saying to them if they were there, such as "I will be there, deep down inside. I will always be here, right by your side." This flip book helps children express their thoughts and feelings and equips them with appropriate coping habits during a traumatic time in their life. For example, one line told from the perspective of the person who has passed says "It's okay to talk about me, to laugh and to cry. It's even okay to question why." There is a page in the book where the reader is invited to share his or her own story and write the memories they have of their special someone. *Turned Upside Down* is a beautiful keepsake that would be a great gift for children and a great tool for counselors and parents.
