The Bloodstone Oracle is the latest in the Dark Gift series, and a person actually COULD read it first, even though it's not the first book. That's one thing I like about The Dark Gifts series...you can read them out of order and still get the gist of what's going on because every book is unique in its POV/character/plot, yet every book links in to the bigger picture. Willow has a way with this technique and personally, I find that a talent in and of itself.

This book is short. I read it in under two hours (and I'm not a fast reader). We meet witches and learn of a prophecy or two (okay, more than two).
