I'm reviewing Daily Walk Bible-NLT: Explore God's Path to Life. I think the ISBN number got messed up or something, because it looks like everyone else is reviewing a different book, but the picture is the same. hmmm

It took me a year and half to read this one year Bible. It's hard to give a lower rating to a Bible, but I can't say I'm overly thrilled with this particular Bible. For one thing, I'm not sure this is actually an NLT version. It doesn't match up with other NLT versions I've seen. Plus, it's really long for a one year version, especially for a slower reader than me. Each day they have an overview of what you are reading, a devotion, and a tidbit about one small area of scripture you are reading that day. The devotions were just ok. They also have a reflection page approximately every 7th day with no scripture reading. That may be great for some people, but as I said, I'm a slow reader. That just made the scripture sections that much longer. For me, it wasn't feasible to complete the Bible in a year with all of that extra reading.
