There was some confusion surrounding this book - for me, anyway. For most of it, I had the feeling I was missing a lot of the story and all of these questions were in my head. I felt like I'd been thrown into the book without a chance to truly get to know the characters.

Oliver and the girl in his dreams were probably the most well-defined characters. I didn't see enough about the other characters to make any decisions about them. Johnny didn't seem that well-defined, although I did like what happened with him and Oliver towards the end.

I liked all of the clues the girl gave Oliver to find her and I also liked the time they spent together in the dreams. The whole concept of people meeting in dreams before they meet in reality was quite an interesting one.

I didn't think the book was entirely clear about what Oliver's relationship with his brother was like. As I recall, there was only one sentence written from his perspective. I would have understood more if some proper interaction between them had been shown.

I did notice some errors in the book, as well as some slightly skewed formatting.

The book was able to hold my attention from the first page and it was a quick, enjoyable read. I did like it.
