This is the first book in the Love series. They will need to be read in order.

His father marries her mother and the emotional torment she gives him increases to a fever pitch. When she moves away, breaking his heart, and then returns, he is left to wonder if

her demons can ever be put to rest. Can they ever have the HEA he wishes to have?

I'm not sure what I expected, but this story idea surpassed my imagination. I didn't realize "I love my stepbrother/sister" was a modern trope, especially since it's near to life in my family. (My sister married our foster-brother.) Now, I'm curious what other authors may invent with this concept.
