This fun and sexy story gives Laney, a trauma surgeon seriously in need of some R&R just what she's looking for. After finding her fiance in a compromising position that resulted in the end of her engagement, a lost job, and no plans for the immediate future, she's going to enjoy what was supposed to be her honeymoon at an exclusive resort that caters to a variety of sexual fantasies along with the traditional fare. Her masseuse seems a bit too rugged and rough to have been working there for long - he's got that military air and the scars to prove that things haven't always been so easy for him. In point of fact though, Gray is at the resort undercover, hoping to catch a notorious drug dealer, the latest intel having him making a stop at the resort. A no strings attached fling is just what the doctor ordered (straight off the 'extra' menu) - until their connection gets to be a bit deeper than either expected. Now Gray's got to choose between keeping his cover or letting Laney in all the way.

This one hit all the right notes for me, with its tropical setting, interesting characters and strong connection between them right from the start. Ladies who pick up Harlequin Blaze novels are looking for a little more sizzle with their romance, and Anne Marsh answers the call with this one. It's hot, steamy, sexy, and erotic, with a little humor and angst mixed for good measure.

“A Lover's Lemonade”, a “Blushing Bride” are just a few of the offerings on a special drink menu at the fantasy island resort that Laney should have been enjoying on her honeymoon, which turned out to be a vacation for one.

Laney, an ER trauma doctor, is going through a very difficult period in her life after breaking up with her fiance, and losing her job. So, she arrives at Fantasy Island alone, but is a little bit clueless about what goes on there. Wink. Wink. Until she meets the resort's Massuer , Gray.

Gray, a SEAL, is at the resort on an undercover mission. The last thing he expected was to find himself very attracted to one of his clients. The ethical issues are in a gray area, but when one of his colleagues, Ashley, pushes him to toward the very attractive doctor, for a little short term fantasy sharing, he puts aside any reservations he may have had.

“It's sex...not rocket science. If you're interested, you tell the guy. Or, better yet, you show him. Most of them need the dots connected for them and that's where the drinks menu comes in. You point him toward your fantasy du jour and skip the awkward stage where he's trying to figure out what you like, and you're trying to figure out to politely tell him it takes a little more for you than a little breast groping and rub-a dub-dub.”

A little fun in the sun at fantasy island is just what Laney needs, but once her time at the resort is up she and Gray will go their separate ways because fantasies are just that... fantasies , right???

The SEAL storyline and the undercover mission thing was a wee bit outlandish, but in my opinion the story was supposed to fun, not taken too seriously, nor weighted down with heavy drama or high emotional intensity. This is a light, escapist type read, for adults only, and taken in the right context, the book is very entertaining and was fun read. This one falls somewhere in between spicy and erotic and is all about acting out one's fantasies, but of course, that could be a dangerous game, because like Laney and Gray soon discovered, those pesky feelings could complicate things, giving them ideas about playing out those fantasies for a lifetime.

I received an ARC of this book in exchange for an an honest review, and here it is.

How's this for a fantasy? The Navy SEAL team, led by the hero, Lt.Commander Gray Jackson and his team, are working incognito as employees at Fantasy Island, a fantasy-sex themed resort somewhere in the Caribbean. Their mission is to apprehend and capture a major player in the drug and arms trade, who is due to arrive there shortly.

En route to Fantasy Island is Dr, Laney Parker, a trauma surgeon at a busy hospital. She was supposed to be on her honeymoon there, but, 3 weeks before the wedding, she walked in on her fiance, an older and well-placed physician at the same hospital, having sex with a nurse. Not only did her engagement end, but it was suggested by the hospital administration that she leave her job to contain what would have become a major scandal and embarrass the hospital as well as her ex. So, Laney decides to at least enjoy her honeymoon reservation alone, hoping to fulfill a few of her own fantasies at the resort.

Lt. Commander Gray Jackson is posing as a masseur at the resort, and when the two meet for Laney's first scheduled massage, Ms. Marsh cranks up the both the heat and the action.

Although I found it difficult to willingly suspend my disbelief that a SEAL team would actually stage a dangerous op at a luxury resort filled with unknowing civilians, it was nevertheless an entertaining read, with one technical exception. There were a number of instances of confusing dialogue. The speaker was seldom identified, and in several conversations this reader was uncertain of who was speaking to who, and had to backtrack to clarify who the speakers were. Identifying the speaker by name occasionally would have alleviated this problem.

All in all, it was a good read with likable characters, and enough heat to say that this is definitely an age 18 and over novel.
