Her mother didn't marry any of the fathers of Dixie's brothers. Gavin is still dealing with the effects of his time in Afghanistan and feels he's a bad bet as a husband. They decide to get engaged, bowing to pressure from Dixie's brothers and hoping that will give their child a more stable life. As Gavin spends more time with Dixie while helping her set up her business, he finds that when he is with her he is happy for the first time since his return.
