Prince of Flight is the story of Keonae & Lark, two people who have more in common than they realize in the beginning of their friendship. Keonae is the brother we read about earlier in the 'King of Prey' series that now lives in the human world and has no desire to return home to the bird realm after suffering a heartless betrayal and attack from the Vultures which left him scarred on his face and body. He has become a loner almost anti-social, never staying anywhere long, and rides a big, loud, motorcycle....Big Bad Biker Bird-Boy!

Lark is also a loner (somewhat of a bada\$\$ herself out of necessity) who is always on the run from her demons, never staying in one place for too long either since the age of thirteen. Like Keonae, she carries scars on the inside as well as the outside due to past traumatic events. She works in a hole-in-the-wall dive that passes for a bar which is where our couple happened to meet and strike up a friendship of sorts.

Keon (Lark calls him that) likes Lark a lot, he feels comfortable in her presence, and has an irresistible pull, an attraction he can't explain or deny. Little does he know, Lark is experiencing similar feelings about Keon and watching the two deal with their emotions is both interesting and humorous.

The story begins with Keon waiting in the poolroom at the back of the bar for his brothers to arrive for a meeting. At this meeting he is updated on the current situation back home, the status of impending war, and what nefarious plans the evil, nasty, Vultures have been carrying out in his absence. A curse on those damn Vultures...I hate'em!! Lark meets the guys and right away they notice something strange going on with Keon and Rossi, that little stinker, adds fuel to the fire with his teasing!

Keanae has been living in the human world for years, ashamed of his scars and not wanting the reminder that his identical triplet brothers give him of his disfigurement. He never even settled in one place until now; until Lark. Lark has been on the run from the bird men for years, and she knows that it is probably time to move on, except that she can't bare the idea of leaving Kean behind, especially when he finally starts acting like he's interested in her...

First thing that I really liked about this was that the characters had known each other for a while. Though the events in the book took place in a short space of time, Lark and Kean had known each other for over a month before hand, and had got to know each other by having breakfast together on multiple occasions. I think that it gave meat to their relationship.

It took Kean a while to become possessive in more than thoughts with Lark, but as soon as he did the chemistry and connection between them was strong, and it felt as if they were already more established as a couple. Of course the other characters surrounding them (mostly from the previous books) had already noticed and these two were a little slow on the upkeep.

I still find the concept of bird shifters intriguing and I think that Roth does it well, not only in how the shifting works but also in how the different races of bird interact. It creates a truly three dimensional world that is completely different to anything I've read before.

I love Mandy Roth's books and have read a lot of them over the years. She is one of my favourite authors and her books never disappoint. 'Prince of Flight' is the sixth book in the absolutely fantastic King of Prey

paranormal romance series about bird shifters from the realm of Accipitridae and the Kingdom of the Royal Eagles as they find their true mates, both shifter and human, in the human realm. I was given a copy by the author in exchange for an honest review and got so absorbed the action, humour and steam that I really didn't want to put it down. I thought I'd just read a bit before breakfast and surfaced just in time for a late lunch.

Bad boy biker and anti-social immortal prince of the Buteos Regalis or Royal Hawks, Keonae, has been living in the human realm since he was attacked, tortured and permanently scarred from head to toe, then left for dead by the evil and sadistic Vultures many years ago. For the last month he's been spending time at a hole-in-the-wall bar and having breakfast with the bar tender, Lark, when her shift finishes in the early hours of the morning. He enjoys her company and they talk a lot, but he really doesn't understand why he's so attached to her. It almost feels like she's his true mate but he's sure the gods wouldn't deem him fit to have one.

Lark has been on the run from bird men for the last thirteen years, ever since the day she killed the evil Cavanie, who murdered her twin and claimed to be their father. Now she can't really stay anywhere for very long, but she's stayed here longer than she should have because she can't bring herself to leave and never see Keonae again. But on this night, when he's having a guys night at the bar or, more accurately, getting an update on the state of things at home with the vultures and the impending war, her demons catch up to her and her crazy nightmare of a life turns upside down...

I'm not going to give any spoilers, but I absolutely loved this action packed story. Written with Mandy's usual sense of humour, I especially loved that Lark is a fighter who not only has a sword collection but knows how to use it and the balcony scene at the end had me in fits of laughter. But there is also sadness and remembered pain for both Keonae and Lark, as well as action, steam and the happily ever after we all expect. There are no cliff-hangers here and, as always, I really can't wait for the next one in this fantastic series.
