Decent country-music-flavored love story. The H was gone on the h from the beginning, although she was prickly for reasons I never really understood. Honestly, I kinda felt the h was a little cold and I never really connected with her, but that might just be me.

For my safety crew, this is safe from OW drama or excessive mentions of the H's sexual past. In fact, the H gives the impression of having been very picky previously. Heroine broke up with most-recent boyfriend over a year ago. She believed the ex-bf was sad but over the breakup, but we learn later on that he was just waiting for her to come back to him. He causes drama with threats of blackmail using some explicit videos and pictures he has of the h. Heroine breaks off with H to protect both of their professional reps, leading to an 8-month separation during which both MCs are faithful. (H even says during the separation that he's still in love with the h, and he will fight to get her back. His bandmate tries to convince him to screw her out of his system, but since he's not a PoS like most romance Hs, he refuses. For that alone, this book got 3 stars.)

One caveat (because I'm so effin' picky): at one point, the manwhore in the H's band picks up two women at a bar. As Mr. Drippydick is leaving with the two ladies, the H ("unapologetically," according to the h) calls him a "lucky bastard". The h laughs about his comment, but I found it a jarring note, considering the fact that the two of them had literally just gotten back together like, the day before, and it's pretty clear that with his talent, rising fame, and good looks, the H could have been menaging his way around town for years already. He talks constantly about respecting women and being raised right, but saying something like that in front of your SO is disrespectful in my opinion. It really took some shine off him for me, and I had been loving him up to that point. It seemed out of character for a man who'd been writing songs about her being his "always" since the minute they met. So why even make that comment? It seemed like inconsistent writing more than anything, but YMMV.
