Difficult to like main characters

Nixon was difficult to warm up to. The scene in which he's having a conversation with his mother revealed him to be spoiled, self-indulgent and without the kind of self awareness that drives both character development and plot. The author alludes to Nixon being a disappointment to his parents and less favored than his sister. But they're still sending checks for his college tuition. That's it? That's the angst?

The female character, Brooklyn, does a slow reveal by removing layers of clothing (but not thinking or emotions) and freaks out twice when touched. Again, that's it?

A very short, extremely readable, first part of a serialized novel about a rough and tough fighter by night, personal trainer by day, and the feisty, secretive young woman who wants him to train her in self-defense. I thought the author did an amazing job writing in the perspective of the male protagonist which can be hard to do plausibly. I see writers slip up all the time while trying to write these big, tough, Alpha males with uncharacteristic feminine traits or worse, what a woman's idea of how a guy thinks and talks. Here, I felt completely like I was inside his head and boy was it hilarious. His ravings and rantings, when taken at face value, could easily persuade the reader that this guy is nothing but a shallow, misogynist, delinquent user but I sense something deeper within. There is a lot of pain, hurt, and fear masked as anger, rage and just general assholeishness.

Nevertheless, it could have been a total wash except that the writer also manages to create an equally three dimensional female protagonist who can give it back to him just as fiercely as he can. This made for some wildly entertaining dialogue, which is always what I look for in these types of stories.
