This is such a wonderful well-written and engaging shifter story and one I enjoyed reading immensely. One cannot help but feel for Chloe and the life she has led up until she meets Cypher. Cypher is now a successful rock star, but still feels the overwhelming guilt at not being able to keep his mother's promise, or find the answers he is looking for. Chloe and Cypher form a bond that cannot be broken, even if family duty and an unforgiving bear, try to intervene to tear their world apart. This is certainly a book I would have no hesitation in recommending.

For the past 4-years, San Francisco is the city Chloe has come to call home. Chloe and her friend Holly are polar opposites, yet their unlikely friendship is a bright spot in Chloe's sometimes dark life. Childhood had not been kind to Chloe; there had been no love or sense of family, only loneliness. Nor any meaningful relationships; her reserve and shyness being interpreted as standoffishness. There is an aching sense of melancholy inside Chloe, a feeling that she wants something she has never known. Cypher is a famous rock star, having been discovered when he was 19-years old; it was the first good thing that had ever happened to

him and his mournful lyrics drew unsurpassed emotion. Of all the bands Cypher has worked with, Elevated is the best; their passion is still alive, reminding him of himself when he was young and idealistic. Nevertheless, fame and fortune haven't given Cypher any of the answers he has been seeking. How many years would he dwell on the past he wonders. Cypher is ready for a break, both physically and emotionally, but he has one more concert to perform. But that night something is different, motivating him to sing harder and with more fervor. Chloe cannot explain the effect Cypher's voice has on her, but from the first time she heard him sing, she was convinced he was somehow singing to her directly. It is ridiculous to harbor such a schoolgirl crush on someone like Cypher, but no amount of logic can diminish the excitement she experiences at the concert; her first time seeing him live is so much better than she expected. When Chloe sees Cypher backstage, her heart stops as he seems to look directly at her, and smiles as if he recognizes her. Fate has brought the two together, but Chloe wonders why Cypher is taking an interest in her; she doesn't believe she is anything special, not realizing the effect her mere presence has on him. Their connection to each other is unlike anything he has known, but Cypher knew exactly what it was. Chloe felt their bond just as strongly, but she seems so timid and afraid of saying or doing the wrong things, but Cypher wants to tell her everything and she cannot recall a time when she has felt more at peace or at ease with anyone. It seems so strange given their first encounter and what she knew about him, but it felt right and she is not afraid of his gift or his power; she feels protected and secure near him. Cypher provides Chloe with emotional support, but more than that his presence empowers her; it is just what she needs when she is called back home suddenly and the two become separated. No matter what Chloe wants or how much she tries to distance herself from Cypher, they were eternally intertwined now, but he would respect her wishes.
