I am a big fan of the mpreg romance and of course, Mr. Walker with his artistic license has his own stamp on this genre. I love the way he writes, his sentence structure, his world usage and his imagination in his world building. There were some nagging questions I had: why did Roman bite Dallas? It was not explained clearly enough to me. Why were the east coast wolves way more aggressive and primitive than the west coast wolves? Dallas's character seemed to expand and grow off the page, embracing his omega that the west coast wolves clearly benefited.
