Adler's use of the story element flashback also helps to generate events that occurred in the past- allowing Cam to solve

the ghost mystery once and for all with her photographic memory. This was an excellent novel, appropriate for children ages 7-10 years old. This novel is a great example of rich, high quality-literature and I recommend it! Other books I might pair with this book would relate to the topics of adventure and mysteries. Other books I might pair with this book might include: Cam Jansen and the Mystery of the Babe Ruth Baseball and Cam Jansen and the School Play Mystery. The book, Cam Jansen and the Ghostly Mystery, by David A. Adler could be used as a mentor text for writing about what it might be like to solve a mystery using your photographic memory. This text could also be used in writer's workshop in order to help children understand imagery and show students how this could be used within their own writing.
