Austin is a self-professed geeky coder who, together with his three buddies, developed a successful dating app. Now they are wealthy and since they employed a matchmaker to make them more presentable, they were named Seattle's Hottest Bachelors. Austin's alter-ego in the Comicon world is Jamie Sinclair, hero of a wildly popular Scottish Highlander series which very much resembles Outlander. With his auburn hair and Scottish heritage, he is a dead-ringer for the actor who plays Jamie Sinclair in the series. Blair is a doctor who has recently returned to Seattle to care for her ill aunt.
