He spins the story from Matthew's point of view, a very sexual and wealthy 38 year old dominant playboy who has no issue sharing his women. He's a bit of a douche but I think that's *why* I liked him so much. He was cocky, domineering, and larger than life but also protective, passionate, and sweet. Matthew has two rules: don't call him anything other than Matthew and don't ask for his number. He holds tight to those rules until Ella literally stumbles into his life.

Ella lands in Matthew's office looking for a job. She's timid, overly thin, and not Matthew's type at all or so he thinks until she sasses him. Ella refuses to call him Matthew and instead calls him Matt. They end up in a rather interesting situation to which Matthew gives Ella a job. After another little push, Matthew takes Ella to live with him in his penthouse. He can't help his attraction or need to protect her.
