She lives well yet is losing weight and appears to have zero money to her name. Drugs? Gambling? And she's nervous around him like she's hiding something. What's her secret? He'll find out.

This was a short but steamy novella. West has a fascination with Bianca and he appears to be just what she needs at this *poor choices* juncture in her life.
